On August 17, 1866 Battle Pieces (and Aspects of the War) was published, including the epic poem "The Scout Toward Aldie," detailing a mission by the 2nd Massachusetts and the 13th and 16th New York Cavalries to find John Singleton Mosby, the Gray Ghost.

Our program will include a talk by Dr. Jonathan Cook of Middleburg Academy on Melville and his poem, including its location and significance.

Additionally, we will use the 165-year old Mt. Zion Church as our venue for a group reading of the poem. The scout actually went by Mt. Zion Church in April 1864. Co-sponsored by MHAA and the Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority.

Join MHAA and NOVA Parks on a driving tour of the Aldie, Middleburg, and Upperville Cavalry Battlefields, the second largest cavalry fight on the North American continent fought as Union and Confederate armies moved north ultimately to Gettysburg from June 17-21, 1863. While many people often speed in their cars past many of the sites where the battles took place, take some time to slow down and explore these unique and preserved historic sites with the education staff of MHAA and NOVA Parks. Sites that will be visited include the 1st Massachusetts Cavalry Monument, Mount Defiance, and the Goose Creek Bridge, among others. The tour will begin at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 1 at the historic Aldie Mill, 39401 John Mosby Highway, Aldie, VA, 20105. Due to limited parking at several sites, attendees will need to carpool with each other along the tour.

Reservations are required for this event. There will be no payments accepted at the start of the program.

There are limited seats available, so purchase your tickets now. Tickets are \$20 per person and can be purchased below.
