update:

12/21/2015 - 12/25/2015

Waterline crews will attempt to break out remaining blue stone at Pendleton St and tie everything together. They will also be performing punch list items at the staging area off of Windy Hill. No work will be performed on the 24th and 25th due to Holiday.

Street light conduit crew is currently scheduled to be onsite after the new year as they have been delayed due to past weather. If they can accelerate elsewhere this may change.

FOLLOWING IS INFORMATION REGARDING: "ROAD CLOSED SIGNS & NO PARKING ADVISORY" FROM OUR CONTRACTOR:

A&M Concrete understands that closing a road down is very inconvenient. It adds extra time onto your day having to detour around the work going on in the area. Lately there has been a lot of confusion about the "Road Closed" signs.

When the sign is placed in the road, whether it is off to the left, right, or in the center of the street, the road is still in-fact closed off. If there are cones next to the sign, and a cone is pushed away enough for a car to squeeze through, the road is still closed. The reason a cone is pushed to the side, or the sign is pushed to the side is for construction vehicles to enter and exit the work area, as well as heavy equipment.

The reason we are closing the road off is because we do not want the public to drive into our work area. It puts our fellow employees at risk, and yourself at risk as well. The sign goes up between the hours of 8:00AM - 9:00AM depending on the area. Some areas we can make due with putting the sign up at a later time. We are not doing this to be jerks or prevent businesses from being open to the public, but to isolate ourselves from the public and keep traffic to a minimum because there is a lot going on in the work area. As you know the town is congested enough with the lane closure and stores having deliveries, so the last thing we would want to do is cause even more traffic build up with a vehicle accident or even worse, an injury.

We understand it is a big hassle, but the quicker we can get the work done, the quicker we will be out of the way. If you own a business and a delivery needs to be made, please let us know. We will accommodate your needs entirely! We understand that everyone has a job to do, and we do not want to put a damper on your business more than we already have with taking up the parking spots in front of the stores.

Also please note that if a meter is bagged off, it is bagged off for a reason. We have the meters bagged off because we intend on doing work in that area and we do not want your vehicle to get damaged. If you work in a business or live in the downtown area and need assistance finding a parking spot for the day, please let us know! We would rather have you ask us where to park, then to park for "5 seconds" and come back to your vehicle with a parking ticket, or even worse, no vehicle because it was towed away.




