Rt. 50 - Washington Street Project:

Beginning Monday, July 18, 2016:

Madison & Pendleton Streets will be open!

Phase three will begin next week, which means switching the traffic lights and closing down Hamilton, Liberty, and Jay street intersections.

Demolition of asphalt and concrete will begin on the intersections listed above.

The traffic signals will be relocated to allow one way traffic through the work zone.

There will be no access to Liberty, Hamilton or Jay Street from Rt. 50.

There will be no entrance to Middleburg Exxon off of Washington Street - Use Marshall Street to Jay Street, enter from there Jay Street entrance.

To access Federal Street take South Madison Street to Federal Street.

Also on Saturday, July 23 - Craft Brew Craze Salamander Resort & Spa in celebrating the 30+ breweries and cideries in Virginia by hosting a festival July 23 called Twilight Tastings. It is the most unique brew-tasting event in the area featuring local breweries,

cideries and distilleries in a stable setting surrounded by beautiful paddocks and horses. Guests can enjoy listening to live music and delectable food designed to pair perfectly with the brews. Craft beer has grown so much that Visit Loudoun has even created a "LoCo Ale Trail" and provide a map with the location and best route to all 17 breweries in the county. Loudoun pairs a modern and urban eastern corridor with wide-open rural seclusion on farms and pastures along the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains in the west. Loudoun's breweries match their local surroundings, as Beltway Brewing, Old Ox, and Ocelot to the east, offer large tasting rooms and refreshing beers for close to Washington DC. Further west, Dirt Farm Brewing, Old 690, and Barnhouse Brewery offer farm brewery experiences with the chance to see firsthand where the beer's ingredients are grown.






