## Rt. 50 - Washington Street Project

### **Rt. 50 - Washington Street Project:**

**Beginning Monday, July 18, 2016:**

**Phase three has Hamilton, Liberty, and Jay street access closed from Rt. 50. You can access business from either Marshall or Federal Streets. The traffic signals allow one way traffic through the work zone.**

**There is an entrance to Middleburg Exxon off of Washington Street - Use bottom exit from the station to Jay Street, to exit the station only - do not exit onto Rt. 50.**

**To access Federal Street take South Madison Street to Federal Street.**

**Work planned for next week:**

**Concrete crews will continue with the installation of granite curb at Jay Street. Will begin forming and grading process at Liberty and Hamilton Streets.**

**Conduit crew will be taking care of foundations and junction boxes.**




