Rt. 50 - Washington Street Project:

Beginning Monday, June 6, 2016:

Concrete crews will continue finish up with granite installation on the north western corner of Pendleton, finish laying out pavers, and begin forming and pouring for the crosswalk.

Storm drain crew will continue operations on Hamilton & Jay street.

MIDDLEBURG TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT PROGRESSING:

Madison and Pendleton Street direct access to Route 50 closed for about seven more weeks.

MIDDLEBURG - Direct access from Madison and Pendleton streets to Route 50 (Washington Street) will be closed for approximately eight weeks, according to the Virginia Department of Transportation, as crews continue work to complete traffic-calming, pedestrian and safety improvements in the Town of Middleburg.

Motorists on Madison Street and Pendleton Street will be able to access

Route 50 by following detour signage.**Access to businesses in the affected areas will be maintained.**

You will be able to access Safeway, Upper Crust, Chip Stine, OD & Croson & Company, Blue and the parking garage for the Courtyard area from their Pendleton Street entrances from Marshall Street, not from Washington Street. The main entrance to Safeway will be closed as will Pendleton Street from Washington Street. You will follow the detour from Marshall to Pendleton.

The entire Route 50 Traffic Calming project is scheduled for completion in October 2016.

NOTICE SPECIAL ELECTION TOWN COUNCIL VACANCY

A special election will be held on Tuesday, November 8th in order to fill a vacancy on the Middleburg Town Council. This vacancy was created by the resignation of Erik Scheps. The successful candidate will fill the remainder of this term, which will expire June 30, 2018.

The Town Council meets on the second and fourth Thursdays of each month at 6:00 p.m. and in special sessions as needed.

In order to be listed as a candidate on the ballot, interested individuals must file the necessary paperwork with the Loudoun County Registrar, Ms. Judy Brown, by the close of business on August 19, 2016. In order to qualify as a candidate, an individual must be a citizen of the United States; be at least eighteen years of age at the time of election; be a resident of the Commonwealth of Virginia for a year immediately preceding the election; reside within the Town of Middleburg; and, be registered to vote in the Town of Middleburg.

Washington St. MHAA will host a rare opening of historic Sunny Bank, a renowned antebellum hunt country home near Middleburg. Sunny Bank was home to Middleburg's Civil War diarist Catherine Broun. It was here that she wrote many of the entries in her diary, which has been edited and published as Dark Days in Our Beloved Country by Lee Lawrence. The event will begin at 2:00 p.m. at the Middleburg United Methodist Church, 15 W. Washington St., in Middleburg. Catherine Broun attended services here during the Civil War. Diary editor Lee Lawrence will speak about Catherine Broun and her family at the church. Following the talk, the program will proceed to Sunny Bank, 22868 Sunnybank Ln., Middleburg, VA. At Sunny Bank, you will be able to see where Catherine made entries in her diary, as well as see the barn where Traveller, Robert E. Lee's famous horse, spent time. 


