§ 36-1. Enforcement and appeals of state standards.

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 6 of Title 36 of the Code of Virginia, the Town of Middleburg adopts the Uniform Statewide Building Code and pursuant to § 36-105 of the Code of Virginia, designates the County of Loudoun as the agency for enforcement and appeals, with the town maintaining the right to issue location permits in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance.¹
