Rt. 50 - Washington Street Project: The Next Two Weeks:

Beginning Monday, May 16, 2016:

A&M Concrete will be switching to the next phase next week. We plan on having our asphalt company out here this Saturday to perform asphalt patching on route 50 and on Pickering Street.

A&M's storm drain crew will continue with the instillation of storm drain and structures from Pendleton to liberty.

Waterline crews are expected to continue on with tie ins and shut downs as well as take care of asphalt restoration patches Thursday & Friday through to Madison.

Conduit crew is expected to be out here about two weeks from now to install their foundations.

You will be able to access Safeway, Upper Crust, Chip Stine, OD & Croson & Company, Blue and the parking garage for the Courtyard area from their Pendleton Street entrances from Marshall Street, not from Washington Street. The main entrance to Safeway will be closed as will Pendleton Street from Washington Street. You will follow the detour from Marshall to Pendleton.

Thank you to all for you patience during the construction.

Pedestrians - please cross streets at crosswalks only - do not walk in the

active work zones.

Those of you who are using Federal Street, Stonewall Avenue and Marshall Streets, Chestnut, Locust, Walnut and or Reed Streets to avoid the traffic lights - please be aware of pedestrians, children riding bicycles, pets, people walking dogs, and obey the speed limits, even go a little slower. Also remember - come to a full stop at all stop signs.

FIELD WORK TO BE CONDUCTED FOR MIDDLEBURG HISTORIC DISTRICT SURVEY UPDATE

Dutton + Associates (D+A) has been contracted by the Town to conduct an architectural survey and prepare an update to Middleburg Historic District documentation. The project is being funded jointly by the Town and the Virginia Department of Historic Resources as part of a Certified Local Government Historic Preservation Grant. Architectural Historians from D+A will be in the Town throughout May 2016 to take photographs and notes on the physical characteristics of buildings and properties within the historic district. All work will be conducted from public right-of-way, and D+A staff will not enter private property unless expressly offered by the landowner. 
