Rt. 50 - Washington Street Project:

Beginning Monday, May 23, 2016:

MIDDLEBURG TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT PROGRESSING:

Madison and Pendleton Street direct access to Route 50 closed for about eight weeks

MIDDLEBURG - Starting tonight, direct access from Madison and Pendleton streets to Route 50 (Washington Street) will be closed for approximately eight weeks, according to the Virginia Department of Transportation, as crews continue work to complete traffic-calming, pedestrian and safety improvements in the Town of Middleburg.

Motorists on Madison Street and Pendleton Street will be able to access Route 50 by following detour signage.

Access to businesses in the affected areas will be maintained.

The entire Route 50 Traffic Calming project is scheduled for completion in October 2016.

A&M Concrete is switching to the next phase.

A&M's storm drain crew will continue with the installation of storm drain and structures from Pendleton to liberty.

Conduit crew is expected to be out here about two weeks from now to install their foundations.

You will be able to access Safeway, Upper Crust, Chip Stine, OD & Croson & Company, Blue and the parking garage for the Courtyard area from their Pendleton Street entrances from Marshall Street, not from Washington Street. The main entrance to Safeway will be closed as will Pendleton Street from Washington Street. You will follow the detour from Marshall to Pendleton.

Thank you to all for you patience during the construction.

Pedestrians - please cross streets at crosswalks only - do not walk in the active work zones.

Those of you who are using Federal Street, Stonewall Avenue and Marshall Streets, Chestnut, Locust, Walnut and or Reed Streets to avoid the traffic lights - please be aware of pedestrians, parents with strollers,

children riding bicycles, pets, people walking dogs, and obey the speed limits, even go a little slower. Also remember - come to a full stop at all stop signs.
