No Construction work on Memorial Day.

Starting Tuesday, May 31:

Concrete crews will continue to dig up Pendleton and Madison intersections for the sidewalks and crosswalks.

Conduit crew will be installing foundations for light poles.

Storm structure/drain crew will be working on Hamilton and Jay street until storm drain is finished.

MIDDLEBURG TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT PROGRESSING:

Madison and Pendleton Street direct access to Route 50 closed for about eight weeks

MIDDLEBURG - Direct access from Madison and Pendleton streets to Route 50 (Washington Street) will be closed for approximately eight weeks, according to the Virginia Department of Transportation, as crews continue work to complete traffic-calming, pedestrian and safety improvements in the Town of Middleburg.

Motorists on Madison Street and Pendleton Street will be able to access Route 50 by following detour signage.

Access to businesses in the affected areas will be maintained.

The entire Route 50 Traffic Calming project is scheduled for completion in October 2016.

You will be able to access Safeway, Upper Crust, Chip Stine, OD & Croson & Company, Blue and the parking garage for the Courtyard area from their Pendleton Street entrances from Marshall Street, not from Washington Street. The main entrance to Safeway will be closed as will Pendleton Street from Washington Street. You will follow the detour from Marshall to Pendleton.


Thank you to all for your patience during the construction.

Also remember - come to a full stop at all stop signs.


