Washington Street Project Update:

A Note from Martha Mason Semmes, Town Administrator:

Thanks to everyone who came out for the "Pardon Our Dust Meeting on the Route 50 Traffic Calming Project. VDOT staff and the contractor for the project A&M Concrete, gave us a summary of the project and a tentative schedule. That schedule has the waterline part of the project starting next week at the Washington Street/The Plains Road intersection, with the bulk of the crosswork to occur during 2016. They will be moving this to another place on their website once construction starts, so keep your eye out for that change. We appreciate everyone's patience during this approximately year-long project. We will all get through this together, and the safer pedestrian crosswalks, street lighting and the new waterline will make it all worthwhile in the end. 




