If a complete application is not filed on or before the 1st of March, the account will be considered delinquent and a 10% penalty will be added to the amount due.

Ensure emergency response and delivery vehicles can find your house by posting your address numbers so they can be seen from the street. Under the Town Code, numbers must be at least four-inches in height.
