#### **State of the Town Address**

On October 27th, Mayor Littleton provided his 3rd annual "State of the Town Address" to the Middleburg community. During this address, the Mayor covered some major topics:

- Fiscal Health: The Town saw a "net operating surplus" of more than \$960,000 in FY21, thanks to higher than expected revenues even during the pandemic. The Town has more than \$6.6 million in fiscal reserve for potential economic downturns.
- New Town Hall Project: The Town Council held two public input sessions on the New Town Hall Project during 2021. The Town also received approval from the Historic District Review Committee, Streetscape Committee, and Planning Commission.
- Key Infrastructure and Planning Efforts: The Town is looking to invest funds from the American Rescue Plan Act to pay for water/ sewer infrastructure projects. The Town Council is also addressing concerns about infill development in the Ridgeview subdivision.
- Town Operations: The Mayor highlighted new staff members that are on board to serve the public. The Town is currently fully-staffed and moving forward on many of the Council's strategic initiatives.
- Engagement in the Community: The Town Council continues to engage through a variety of events, Committees, and partnerships, to include working with other Towns and County partners to help keep Middleburg a wonderful place to live.
