PEDDLERS, CANVASSERS AND SOLICITORS

§ 73-1. Prohibition; penalties.

§ 73-1. Prohibition; penalties.

The practice of going in and upon private residences in the town by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant merchants and transient vendors or merchandise, not having been requested or invited so to do by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of said private residences, for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares and merchandise and/or for the purpose of disposing of and/or peddling or hawking the same, is declared to be a nuisance and as such shall be punishable as a misdemeanor.
