

A Guide to What You Can Not Flush Down the Drain

- Do not flush hair down your drain. Use a drain protector for your bathtubs and sinks .
- Do not dump grease, oil, or fat down the sink. Instead, pour grease and fat into a jar and throw it in the trash.
- Do not flush baby wipes, diapers, tampons, contraceptives or anything else besides toilet paper down the toilet! "Flushable" does not mean it is flushable.
- In addition, do not flush the following: pharmaceuticals, cleaning products, plastics, towels, pesticides, and any other thing that is not human waste or toilet paper.
