Walk Middleburg fun walks

This year, in place of the previous 5K runs which were restricted to runners, we have created three enjoyable walking tours to take in our quaint town, together with the delightful grounds of the Hill School, just to the south. Customized maps will be provided which include QR (Quick Response) codes which allow you to hover the camera of your smart phone over the code, taking you directly to the walking route on your phone! All walks begin and end at the Middleburg Community Center, with walk number one being a mile, taking you east down Washington Street and then left to take in Marshall Street, past the Town Office and back to Washington Street at Jay Street and home to the Community Center.

Walk number two is two miles, and this is one of two walks which will take you from Washington Street south on Pendleton Street and into the beautiful grounds of the Hill School, Middleburg's independent K-8 school.

The third walk, three miles long, is an extension of walk number two and will take you around the perimeter of the Hill School, a country excursion within the safe confines of the school's grounds.

We are putting together a fun scavenger hunt for the walks whereby you will be tasked to spot certain landmarks and themes, either take a photo or sketch it and the more you spot, the better your chance of a draw prize at the end.
